

FAST FACTS FROM THE 2016 UGANDA DHS

The 2016 Uganda Demographic and Health Survey (UDHS) is designed to provide data for monitoring the health situation in Uganda. The 2016 UDHS is the 4th DHS survey conducted in Uganda since 2000-01. It provides reliable estimates at the national level, for urban and rural areas, for 15 regions, and for 3 special areas.

CHILDHOOD MORTALITY




Childhood mortality has sharply declined since 2000-01.

Trends in Childhood Mortality


Deaths per 1,000 live births for the five-year period before the survey



MALARIA

Malaria Prevalence by Region

Percent of children age 6-59 months who tested



30% of children age 6-59 months tested positive for malaria by rapid diagnostic test.

Malaria prevalence ranges from 1% in Kampala region to 69% in Karamoja region.

MATERNAL HEALTH



3 in 5 women age 15-49 attend 4+ antenatal care visits.









3 in 4 births are delivered in a health facility.
