
FAST FACTS FROM THE 2018 MOZAMBIQUE MIS

The 2018 Mozambique Malaria Indicator Survey (IIM) provides population-based estimates on malaria indicators to inform strategic planning and program evaluation. The 2018 LMIS is the 6th survey to be conducted in Mozambique through The DHS Program.

MALARIA PREVALENCE

Malaria prevalence in children by province


Percent of children age 6-59 months who tested positive for malaria by rapid diagnostic test (RDT)



39% of children age 6-59 months tested positive for malaria by rapid diagnostic test.

Malaria prevalence ranges from a low of 1% in Maputo Cidade and Maputo Província to a high of 57% in Cabo Delgado.

MALARIA PREVENTION



73% of children under 5 and **76%** of pregnant women age 15-49 slept under an ITN the night before the survey.



41% of pregnant women age 15-49 received 3+ doses of IPTp to prevent malaria in pregnancy.
