
2021 Malaria Indicator Survey

The 2021 Nigeria Malaria Indicator Survey (NMIS) is designed to provide data for monitoring the population and health situation in Nigeria. The 2021 Nigeria MIS is the 3rd Malaria Indicator Survey conducted in Nigeria.

OWNERSHIP OF ITNS

Trends in ITN Ownership

Percent of households that own at least one ITN and percent of households with at least one ITN for every two people



56% of households own at least 1 **insecticide-treated net (ITN)**.

25% of households own at least 1 ITN for every 2 people in the household.

USE OF ITNS

36% of the household population slept under an ITN the night before the survey.

This varies by zone, from **19%** of the household population in South South zone, to **49%** in North East and North West zones.

Use of ITNs by Zone


Percent of household population who slept under an ITN



MALARIA PREVALENCE

Trends in Malaria Prevalence

Percent of children age 6-59 months who tested positive for malaria by microscopy



1 in 5 (22%) children age 6-59 months tested positive for malaria by microscopy. Malaria prevalence has declined by nearly half since 2010.
