## HEALTH AND WELL-BEING

## Maternal Health

2 in 3 women had 4 or more ANC visits during pregnancy.
$89 \%$ of births were delivered by a skilled provider. *

* Skilled provider is a doctor, nurse, midwife, or clinical officer.

## Malaria

Access and use of insecticide-treated nets (ITNs) is higher in malaria endemic areas.

## Child Health

4 in 5 children age $12-23$ months have been fully vaccinated against tuberculosis, polio, tetanus, pertussis, diphtheria, and measles.

$80 \%$ of girls and $76 \%$ of boys age 24-59 months are developmentally on-track in health, learning, and psychosocial well-being.

## Nutritional status of children

Child nutrition has improved in the last two decades. The proportion of children under age 5 who are stunted (too short for their age) has halved, from 36\% to II 8\%.

Trends in child growth measures
Percentage of children under age 5 who are malnourished


Breast and cervical cancer screening is low. $1 \mathbf{4 \%}$ of women have ever been screened for breast cancer and II7\% for cervical cancer.

## Alcohol and tobacco use

Percentage of women and men age 15-49 who consumed at least one alcoholic drink in the last month or use any type of tobacco

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Tobacco and alcohol use is higher in men than in women. I $2 \%$ of men use tobacco and $26 \%$ use alcohol.
