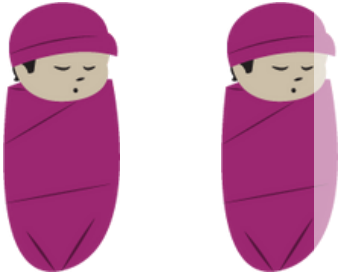


2022 PHILIPPINE NATIONAL DEMOGRAPHIC AND HEALTH SURVEY (NDHS)

The 2022 NDHS is the 8th Demographic and Health Survey conducted in the Philippines since 1993 and is designed to provide data to monitor the population and health situation in the Philippines.

Fertility & Family Planning

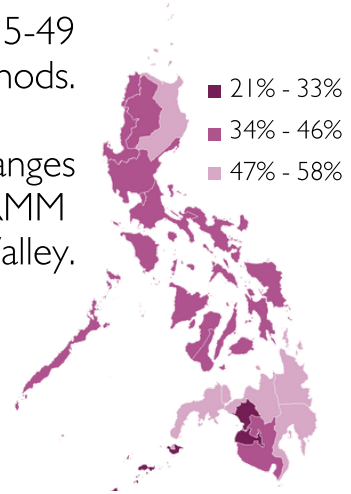


Women have an average of **1.9** children.

Fertility has declined from **4.1** children per woman in 1993.

42% of married women age 15-49 use modern family planning methods.

Modern family planning use ranges from **21%** of women in BARMM to **58%** in Cagayan Valley.



5% of women age 15-19 have ever been pregnant.

Maternal Health



More than **4** in **5** pregnant women made 4 or more antenatal care visits.

89% of live births were delivered in a health facility, but **11%** were delivered at home.

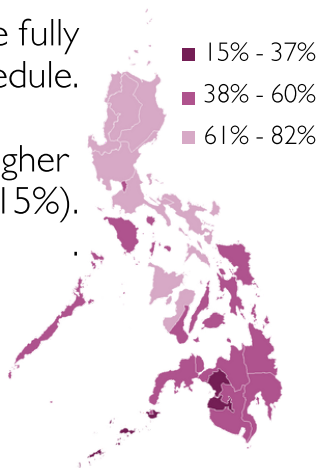


75% of women & **80%** of newborns received a postnatal check within the first 2 days after birth.

Children's Health and Status

59% of children age 12-23 months are fully vaccinated according to the national schedule.

Vaccination coverage is five times higher in CALABARZON (82%) than in BARMM (15%).



In 2022, **twice** as many children **survive to their 5th birthday** than in 1993.



More than **3** in **4** in children age 24-59 months are developmentally on track in health, learning, and psychosocial well-being.
