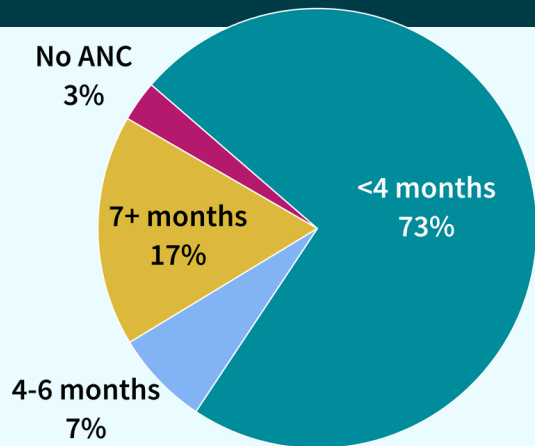

2023 Population and Family Health Survey

The 2023 Jordan Population and Family Health Survey (JPFHS) is designed to provide data for monitoring the population and health situation in Jordan. The 2023 JPFHS is the 8th Demographic and Health Survey conducted in Jordan since 1990.

Maternal and Newborn Health



73% of ever-married women age 15-49 had their first antenatal care visit in the first trimester.



99% of births are delivered in a health facility.

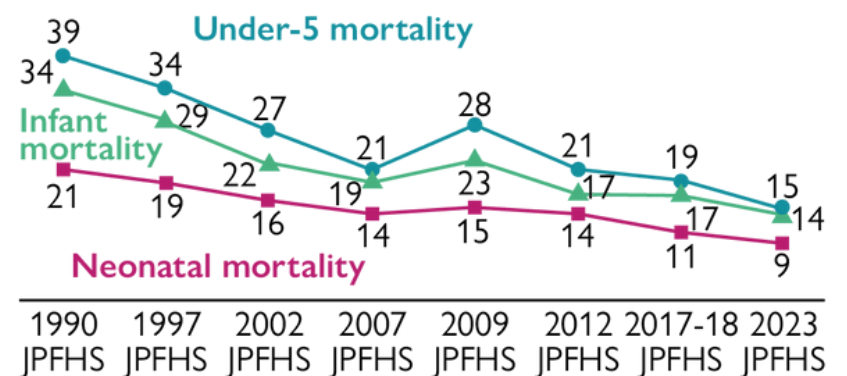
Childhood Mortality

Childhood mortality rates have declined over time. The **under-5 mortality** rate is **15 deaths** per 1,000 live births.

1 in **67** children in Jordan does not survive to their 5th birthday.

Trends in Childhood Mortality

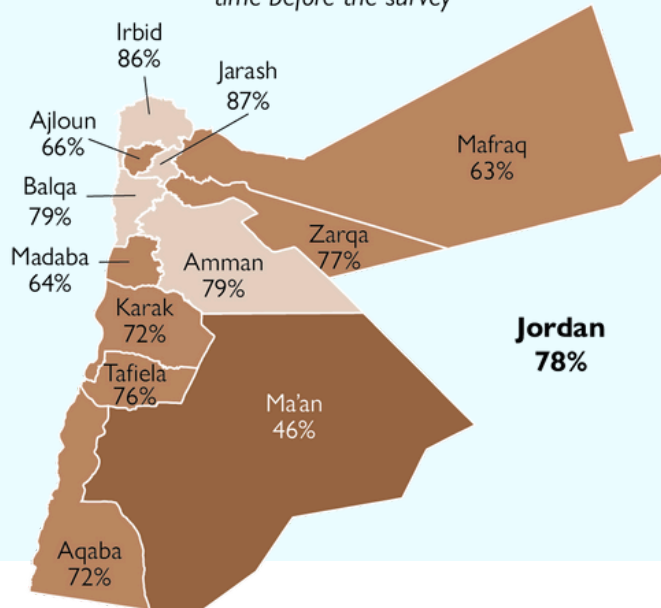
Deaths per 1,000 live births for the five-year period before the survey



Child Health

Vaccination Coverage by Governorate

Percent of children age 12-23 months who are fully vaccinated according to the national schedule at any time before the survey



78% of children age 12-23 months are fully vaccinated according to the Jordan national schedule.

92% are fully vaccinated with 8 basic antigens (BCG, Polio 1-3, DPT 1-3, Measles).
