


2012-13 Pakistan Demographic and Health Survey

Fertility

Pakistani women now have an average of 3.8 children. Women have 1.6 fewer children than in 1990-91.

Births per woman for the 3 years prior to the survey




*1990-91 figure based on 6 years prior to the survey

■ ≤20% ■ 21%-40% ■ ≥41%




Maternal Health

A little over half of births are assisted by a skilled provider. Women with higher education are most likely to have their births attended by a skilled provider.

Percent of live births in the 5 years before the survey delivered by a skilled provider by mother's education




Child Mortality

Infant mortality has decreased from 91 deaths per 1,000 live births in 1990-91 to current level of 74 deaths per 1,000 live births.

■ 1990-91 PDHS (1986-1990) ■ 2006-07 PDHS (2002-2006) ■ 2012-13 PDHS (2008-2012)




Vaccination Coverage

Vaccination coverage has gradually increased in Pakistan. More than 5 in 10 children age 6-23 months are fully vaccinated.
