


Trends in Ownership and Use of ITNs



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Trends in Experience of Spousal Violence

Almost **1/2 of women** and **1/5 of men** have experienced spousal violence

The 2019-20 Rwanda Demographic and Health Survey (2019-20 RDHS) was implemented by the National Institute of Statistics of Rwanda (NISR) in collaboration with the Ministry of Health (MOH). The funding for the 2019-20 RDHS was provided by the Government of Rwanda, United States Agency for International Development (USAID), the United Nations Children Fund (UNICEF), the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), Enabel (Belgian Development Agency), UNWOMEN and Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). ICF provided technical assistance through The DHS Program.

The maternal mortality ratio (MMR) for the 5 years before the survey is **203 deaths per 100,000 live births.**

This excludes deaths due to accidents or violence, so is not comparable to estimates from previous surveys.


2019-20 Rwanda Demographic and Health Survey (RDHS)

The 2019-20 Rwanda Demographic and Health Survey (RDHS) provides data for monitoring the health situation of the population in Rwanda. The 2019-20 RDHS is the 6th Demographic and Health Survey conducted in the country. The survey is based on a nationally representative sample. It provides estimates at the national and provincial levels, as well as for urban and rural areas.


Trends in No Education

Percent of women and men age 15-49 with no education




Trends in Total Fertility Rate

Percent of married women age 15-49 currently using family planning




14% of married women have an unmet need for family planning.



Three-quarters (75%) of the demand for family planning is satisfied by modern methods.


Trends in Demand for Family Planning

Percent of married women age 15-49




Trends in Childhood Mortality
