

# Maternal and Child Health: Results from the 2012 TjDHS

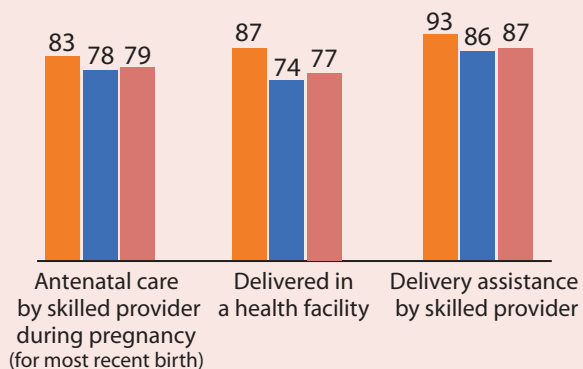
The 2012 Tajikistan Demographic and Health Survey (TjDHS) provides up-to-date information on the population and health situation in Tajikistan. The 2012 TjDHS is the first national demographic and health survey conducted in the country.

The 2012 TjDHS included questions on antenatal care, delivery care, and postnatal care, as well as questions on childhood vaccinations, illnesses, and mortality.

## Timing of Antenatal Care

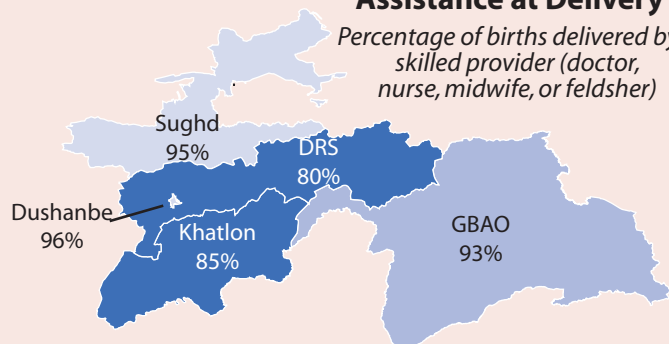
53% of pregnant women received the recommended 4+ antenatal care visits



52% of women attended their first ANC visit during their 1st trimester of pregnancy, as recommended.

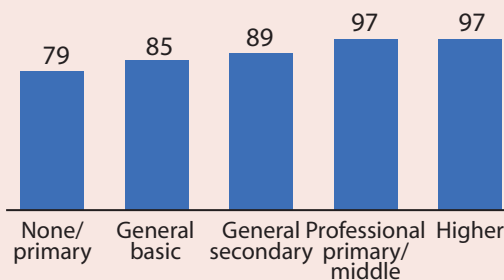
## Assistance at Delivery

Percentage of births delivered by a skilled provider (doctor, nurse, midwife, or feldsher)

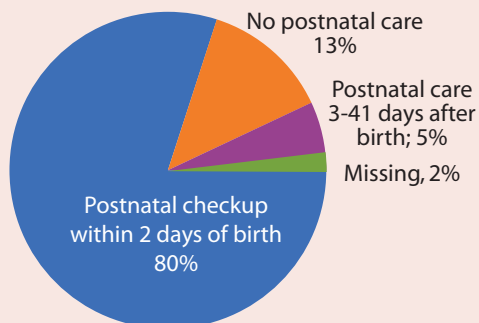


## Delivery Assistance by Education

Percentage of births delivered by a skilled provider (doctor, nurse, midwife, or feldsher)

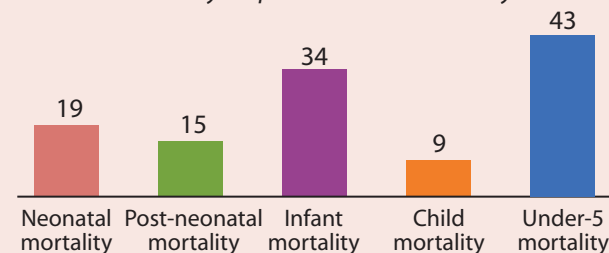


## Timing of Postnatal Care



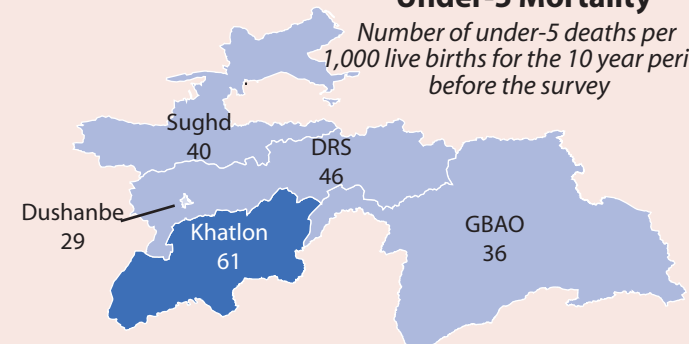
## Childhood Mortality

Deaths per 1,000 live births for the 5 year period before the survey



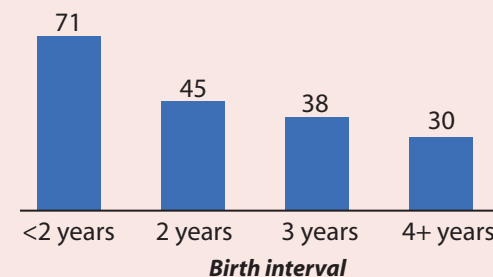
## Under-5 Mortality

## Under-5 Mortality by Birth Interval

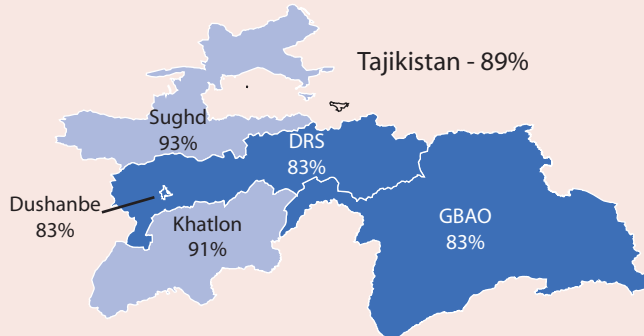
Number of under-5 deaths per 1,000 live births for the 10 year period before the survey

## Vaccination coverage

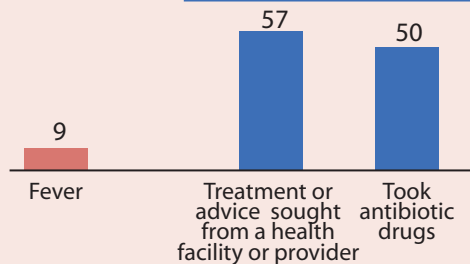
Percentage of children 18-29 months who have received all basic vaccinations (BCG, measles or MR, and 3 doses each of DPT/pentavalent and polio)

Percentage of children under 5 with fever

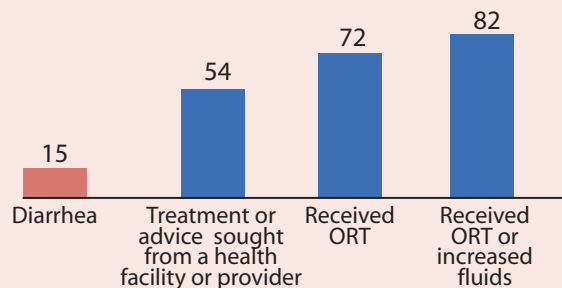
Among children with fever, percentage receiving treatment
